## ? Frequently Asked Questions

#### (L) When do practices begin?

Practices kick off in early November! Once your athlete is placed on a team, you'll receive the official practice schedule within a few days. Please make sure all forms and the first payment are submitted before the first practice.

We understand athletes may still be wrapping up their youth cheer commitment—we totally get it! Please keep your commitment and attend our practices the best you can. Conflicts related to youth programs will be excused through early November until their last competition for the fall season. After that, it's time to go full GEA mode!

## **Attendance Policy**

Absences must be communicated to your coach at least 48 hours in advance. We understand that life happens—family emergencies and graded school events are excused. Everything else? We expect you there! Sick athletes are still expected to attend practice even if they need to sit out and watch.

Unexcused Absences = \$50 fee per occurrence.

After two unexcused absences, we'll schedule a meeting with the athlete and parent(s). Continued issues may result in removal from the team. We count on every athlete to help us deliver amazing performances!

○ Pre-Competition Policy: Missing a practice the week before a competition—or two weeks before a national event—could lead to changes in routine placement or removal from that event.

## Holiday & Vacation Policy

We love a good vacation too—but not during cheer season! Absences affect the whole team. Please plan travel during our scheduled gym closures. Choreography clinics are mandatory, and any excessive absences or loss of skills could affect your athlete's team placement.

#### **Practice Attire**

GEA style = Black sports bra, black shorts, or approved GEA practice wear only (no stripes, prints, or off-brand colors). Hair in a high ponytail with a bow—black, gold, or white preferred. No jewelry allowed. Cheer shoes are a must at all times.

#### **Tuition & Payments**

- ◆ Monthly Tuition: \$179 (November 1st through April 1st)
- 6 Unlimited Tumbling Add-On: \$129/month for GEA families

• Midseason Fee Installments (Includes uniform, bow, music, choreography, competition & coaching fees):

- \$395 due October 15
- \$395 due November 15
- \$197.50 due December 15
- \$197.50 due January 15

All families must create an account in our Amilia System. Invoices for the full season will be visible—no surprises here! A valid credit card must remain on file. Transactions include a 2.9% convenience fee. Monthly fees are charged automatically on the 1st of each month.

Accounts more than 5 days past due incur a \$50 late fee. Athletes with outstanding balances may attend practice, but will not participate in classes, private lessons, or competitions until the account is current. There are NO refunds for missed practices, injuries, or voluntary withdrawals. If you start the season late, you're still responsible for the full fee schedule. Uniforms must be returned if payment is incomplete. If you're having financial difficulties, reach out to us ASAP. We'll do our best to work with you!
