SPRING BREAK NOTE: GEA does not close for spring break because school districts take different weeks off and our competition season is still in progress. Athletes are expected at practice unless an absence is approved.

BID OPPORTUNITY: If a team earns a Full Paid Gold Bid to US Finals at one of our competitions, GEA intends to accept it. Event details, travel expectations, and dates will be shared if a bid is earned. This year it is in Sandy, UT

PRACTICE KICKOFF: Practices begin the first week of November. Team schedules arrive shortly after placement, and all forms, plus the first payment, are due before the first practice. Youth cheer conflicts are excused through the athlete's final fall competition in early November. Athletes are expected to attend GEA practices whenever there isn't a schedule conflict with their youth cheer schedule.

Show Up. Work Hard. Shine Together.

Cheer is a team sport, and every athlete matters. When one athlete is missing, stunt groups, formations, timing, and the entire routine are affected. Consistent attendance keeps everyone safe, confident, and competition-ready.

Attendance Policy

- Family emergencies, such as a death in the family and graded school events are excused.
- All other absences are considered unexcused unless approved by GEA.
- Sick or injured athletes are still expected to attend practice and observe when they are able to do so safely.

UNEXCUSED ABSENCE FEE: \$50 per occurrence. After two unexcused absences, GEA will schedule a meeting with the athlete and parent or guardian. Continued attendance issues may result in removal from the team.

The Week Before Competition

Missing practice during competition week - or during the two weeks before a national event - may lead to routine changes, reassignment of positions, or removal from that event. These decisions are made for team safety and readiness.

Holidays, Vacations & Choreography

We love a vacation too, but midseason moves fast! Please schedule travel during published gym closures whenever possible. Choreography clinics are mandatory. Excessive absences or loss of required skills may affect an athlete's team placement.

GEA Practice Look

Come ready to train - polished, safe, and in GEA style.

- Black sports bra and black shorts, or approved GEA practice wear
- No stripes, prints, or off-brand colors
- Hair in a high ponytail with a bow; black, gold, or white preferred
- No jewelry
- Cheer shoes must be worn at all times

Select practice items may be available in the GEA Spirit Shop.

TEAM-FIRST REMINDER: Strong attendance, a positive attitude, and the right practice gear help athletes get the most out of every minute in the gym.

Billing Basics

- Every family must create an account in the Amilia system.
- The mid-season invoice will be visible in the account, so families can see the complete payment schedule.
- A valid credit card must remain on file.
- Amilia technology Fee that includes credit card/Echeck processing fee is 3.9% charged to all transactions except cash
- Monthly tuition is charged automatically on the first of each month.
- GEA accepts cash, checks, money orders, and major credit cards, excluding American Express.

Late Payments, Participation & Refunds

- Accounts more than five days past due will receive a \$50 late fee.
- Athletes with an outstanding balance may attend team practice, but may not participate in classes, private lessons, or competitions until the account is current.
- There are no refunds for missed practices, injuries, or voluntary withdrawal.
- Athletes who join after the season begins are still responsible for the full fee schedule.
- Uniforms must be returned if payment is incomplete.

Early Termination Fee (Liquidated Damages)

Because Golden Elite Allstars incurs non-recoverable expenses including choreography, music licensing, coaching contracts, competition registrations, and administrative costs at the beginning of the season, early withdrawal creates financial damages that are difficult to calculate precisely.

If a family voluntarily withdraws or is released from the program after team placement, an Early Termination Fee of \$600 will be assessed as liquidated damages. This amount represents a reasonable estimate of anticipated damages. It is not intended as a penalty. It reflects costs already incurred and administrative losses associated with withdrawal. The Early Termination Fee is in addition to: Any unpaid tuition during the required 30-day notice period. Any non-refundable third-party fees already committed.
